- Enhances Animal Productivity
- Upgrades information network on animal productivity
- Prevention and control of animal diseases
- Update the farmers with new technologies

Prof. M.C.Varshneya, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of Kamdhenu University said that this project will help farmers to double their income. As the soil Health Card is helping farmers to improve soil fertility, in a similar way e-Animal Health Card will help farmers to improve their socio-economic status through scientific animal husbandry.
