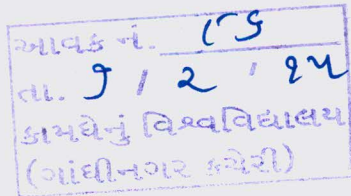

Appendix-A

Regulations for award of Vice-Chancellor's Gold Medal for Diploma holders of all Faculties of Kamdhenu University

1. The Medal shall be called "Vice-Chancellor's Gold Medal".
2. An amount for Gold Medal of 10 gm. Weight with 18 Carat purity, along with cost of preparations of the Medal and other charges shall be utilized from the University fund.
3. The Medal shall be awarded to the best Diploma holder of each faculty.
4. The award shall be made to a Diploma holder of all the faculties by the Board of Management on recommendation of the Academic Council and shall be declared at the annual convocation.
5. A committee consisting of
 - (A) Director of Research and Dean P.G. - Chairman
 - (B) Expert (Nominated by Vice-Chancellor)
 - (C) Principal/Dean (By rotation every Year)shall decide the awardee for the Gold Medal and the decision of the committee shall be final.
6. The award shall be made to a Diploma students of all the faculties whose overall performance in study (O.G.P.A) at the end of final year of degree course examination and participation in Sport/Cultural, N.C.C/N.S.S, Essay, Debate competition and Mountaineering Course at Under Graduate level sponsored by the University will be judged as per guidelines.
7. The office of the Registrar will submit the names of Top Ten highest Marks/OGPA scoring Students of all faculties for consideration for the award.
8. The concerned Dean of each faculty shall prepare the comparative merit list of Ten students after taking into consideration, the academic merit and extra curricular activities (as per guidelines) and submit the list of first five students to the committee of experts constituted vide Rule 5 as referred above. The Committee of experts shall judge the comparative merit of the candidates of all the faculties and shall select the best among them for each faculty.
9. A student shall not be eligible for the award of the medal if he/she:
 - (i) Secures less than first class or secures 'F' (Fail) or 'US' (Unsatisfactory) or 'I' (Incomplete) grade at any time in course
 - (ii) Dropped the (Barring withdrawal) course as regular students
 - (iii) Left the course incomplete or
 - (iv) Was on conduct probation at any time for his/her misconduct/ misbehaviour up to the end of final year examinations
